Senate Bill 998 Disconnection of Water Service Appeal

Per California Senate Bill 998 (Dodd - 2018) a water supplier may not shut off residential water service if <u>all</u> of the following three conditions are met:

(1)	I am the primary care provider for	and certify

	will be life threatening to or will pose a serious threat to the health and	
	safety of, a resident of the premises where residential service is provided.

	Current recipient of California Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children, or	
	I declare under penalty of perjury that the household's annual income is less than 200 percent of the federal poverty level.	
(3)	Initial indicating that you are willing to enter into an amortization agreement (not to exceed 12 months).
